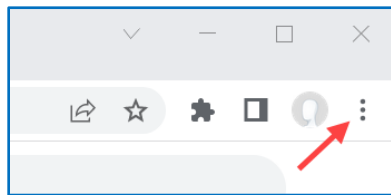
Google Chrome

Below are the steps to be taken to clear the browser cache and reconfigure any browser website autoloads for the Google Chrome.

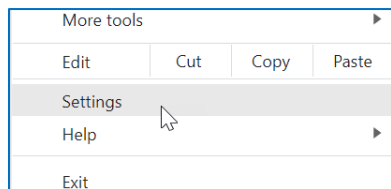
Clearing the Cache

To clear the browser cache, do the following;

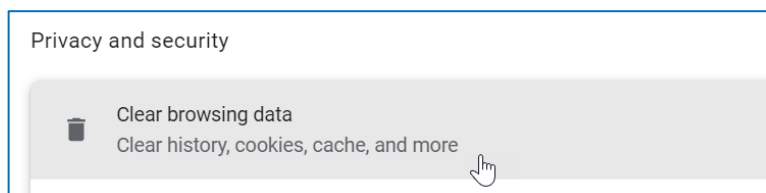
- Open the browser and click in the vertical ellipsis located on the upper right corner



- From the dropdown menu, select the **Settings** entry.



- At the **Settings** page, from the left **Navigation** pane, click on **Privacy and security**.
- In the right information pane, scroll down to the **Privacy and security** section and click on **Clear browsing data**.

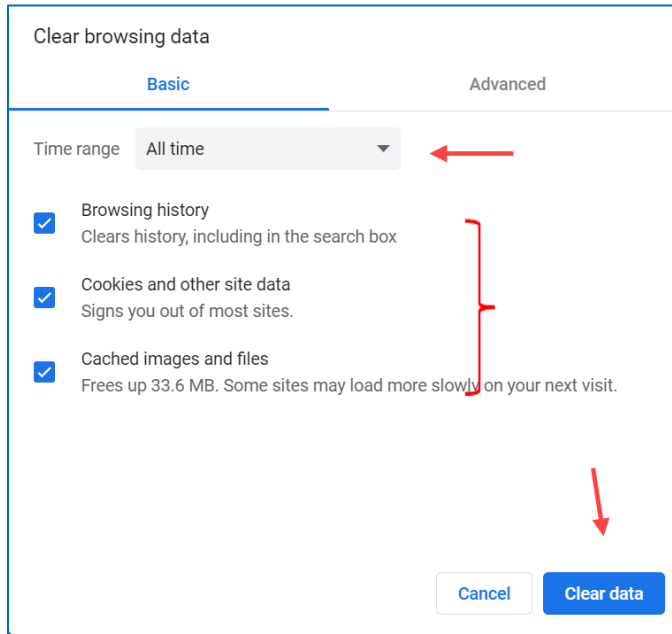


- At the **Clear browsing data** window, select the following **Basic** settings;
Time range : All time
 Browsing history
 Cookies and other site data
 Cached images and files

Note:

There are additional categories under the **Advance** tab but are not necessary for the browser's acknowledgment of website security.

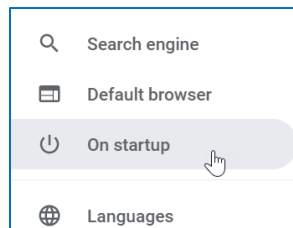


- When completed click the **Clear data** button.

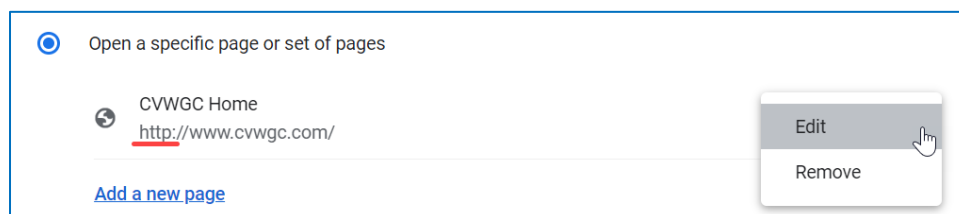
Browser Auto Load

To reset the website autoload, do the following;

- From the **Setting** page, in the left **Navigation** pane select **On startup**.




- In the **On startup** information pane, click vertical ellipsis (⋮) to the left of the **Open a specific page or set of pages** entry and from the dropdown menu click the **Edit** entry.

- At the **Edit page** window, edit the **Site URL** as follows;
From : `http://www.cvwgc.com`
To : `https://www.cvwgc.com`

- Click the **Save** button to complete the process.

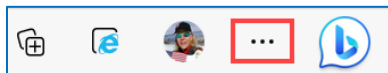
Microsoft Edge

Below are the steps to be taken to clear the browser cache and reconfigure any browser website autoloads for the Microsoft Edge.

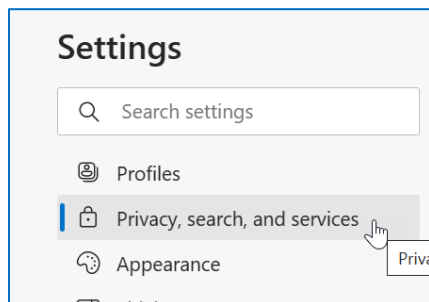
Clearing the Cache

To clear the browser cache, do the following;

- Open the browser and click the horizontal ellipsis located in the upper right corner of the browser.

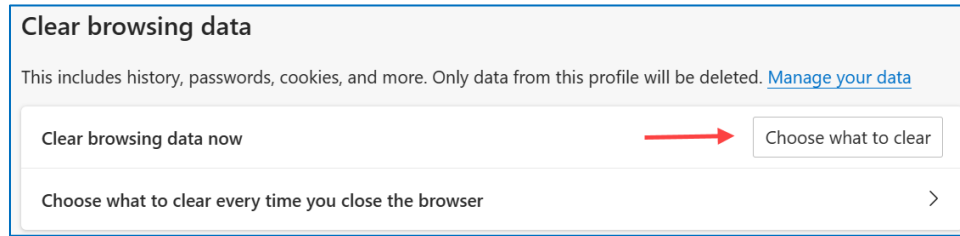


- From the dropdown menu, scroll down and select the **Settings** entry.
- In the **Setting** left navigation pane, select the **Privacy, search and services** entry.

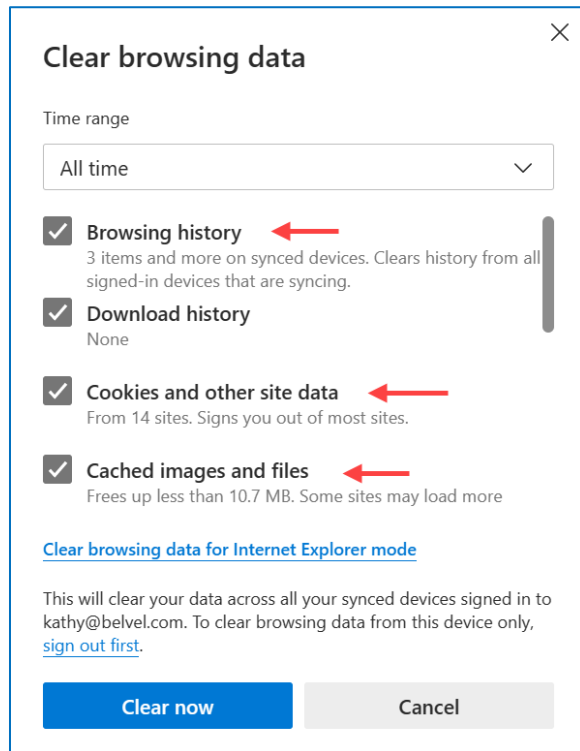

- In the right **Information** pane, scroll down to the **Clear browsing data** section and click the **Choose what to clear** button.



- At the **Clear browsing data** window, select the following three (3) categories;
 - Browsing history
 - Cookies and other site data
 - Cached images and files
- Click the blue **Clear now** button.



Note:

There are additional categories but they are not necessary for browser acknowledgment of website security.

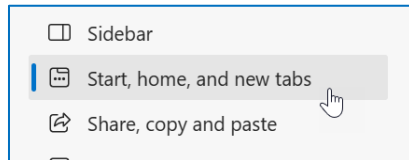
If you are still using an old IE (Internet Explorer) browser select the **Clear browsing data for Internet Explorer** section directly below the **Clear browsing data** section from above and follow the same process.

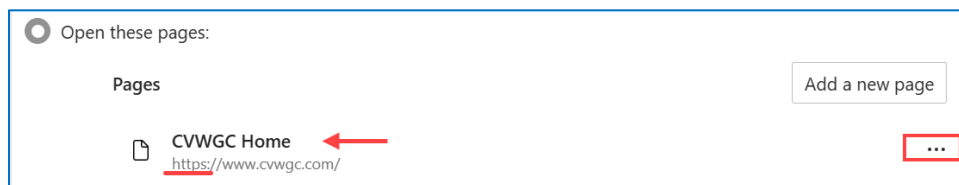
Browser Auto Load

To reset the web page autoloading, do the following:

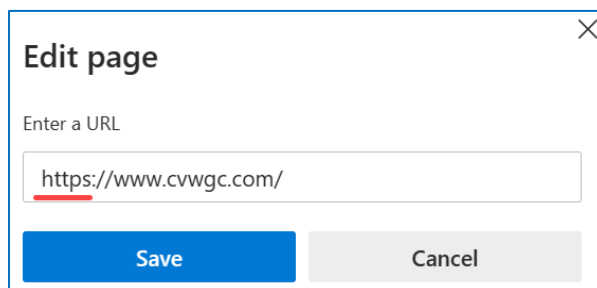
- From the **Settings** left **Navigation** pane, select **Start, home, and new tabs** entry



- In the right information pane, under the **When Edge starts** section, confirm that the **Pages** under the **Open these pages:** has the URL is pointing to "https". If it is not, click the horizontal ellipsis located to the right on the **CVWGC** entry, and select **Edit** from the dropdown menu.



- At the **Edit page** window, edit the **URL** as follows:
From : `http://www.cvwgc.com`
To : `https://www.cvwgc.com`



- Click the **Save** button to complete the process.

Mozilla Firefox

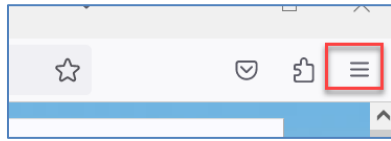
Below are the steps to be taken to clear the browser cache and reconfigure any browser website autoloading for the Microsoft Edge.

Clearing the Cache

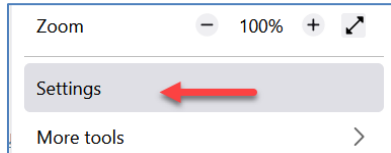
- Open the **Firefox** browser.

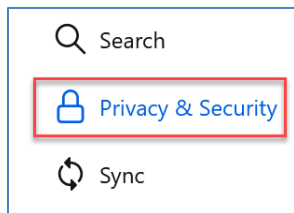
- In the upper right corner of the browser, click on the **Hamburger** button/symbol (the triple bar ≡ or trigram symbol ≡).



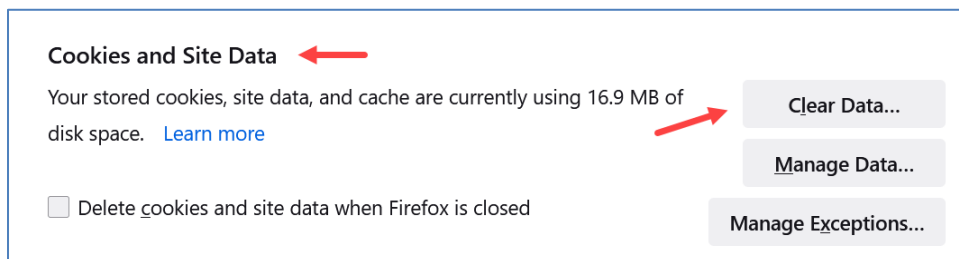
- From the dropdown menu, select the **Settings** entry.



- In the left navigation pane of the **Settings** window, click the **Privacy & Security** entry.



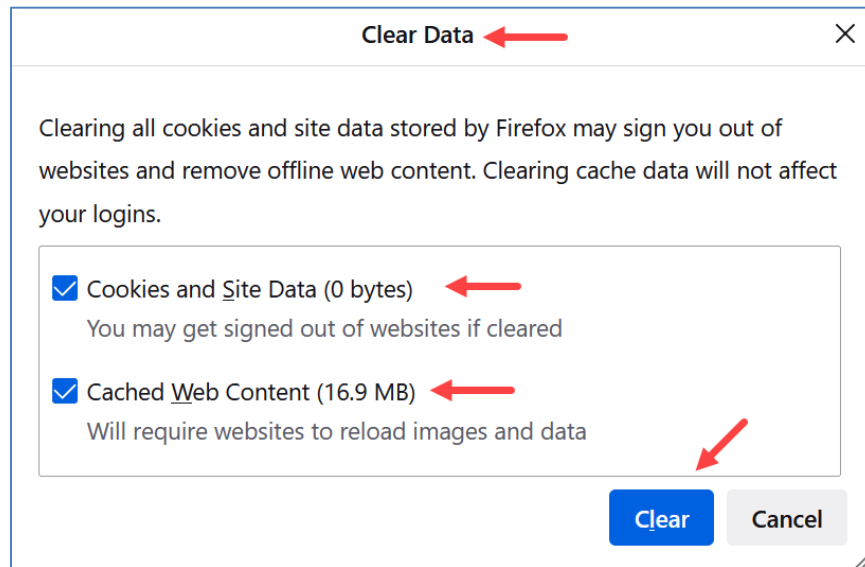
- At the **Browser Privacy** window pane, scroll down to the **Cookies and Site Data** section and click the **Clear Data...** button.



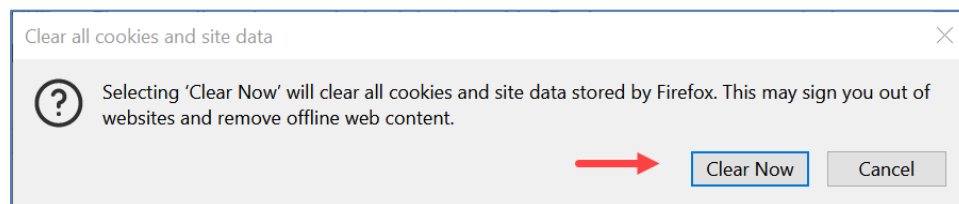
- At the **Clear Data** window, ensure the following are both selected;
 - Cookies and Site Data
 - Cached Web Content

- And click the blue **Clear** button.



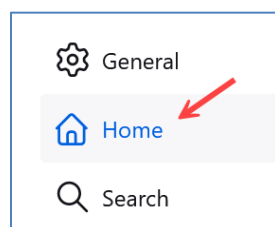
- At the **Clear all cookies and site data** information window, click the **Clear Now** button.



Browser Auto Load

If your Firefox browser opens to the CVWGC website at startup, you may need to edit the address as follows.

- From the settings page (see instructions above) select the **Home** entry in the left navigation pane.

- At the **Home** page, under the **New Windows and Tabs** section, edit the **CVWGC** website **URL** as follows;
