**1. Club-Related Concerns** include discrepancies on results, payouts, foursome and cart pairings, game postings, and problems with other members, CVGC employees, etc.

**2. Rules Concerns:** Any member who has issues or concerns related to rules should contact Rules Chair Patti Parker. If Patti is unable to resolve the issue, she will engage the Board for assistance. If the Board is unable to satisfactorily resolve the issue, then the Board will bring it to the Club Pro.

**3. Course Etiquette:** Any concern a member has regarding non-members' course etiquette, (such as hitting up on you, playing too slow for the size of their group, unsportsmanlike conduct) should be directed to the Pro Shop. Club members should call the Pro Shop to reports these types of incidents and not to engage with the non-member players. We should all add the Pro Shop to our cell phone contact lists.

**Club Championship:** This 2-week series starts next week, Sept. 14. Rules for competing in the Club Championship tournament are as follows:

- 1. Competitors:** Competitors must be a member in good standing for prior two months. They must have an established USGA handicap. They must have played at least five (5) 18-hole rounds on Ladies Days. They must play both rounds on the scheduled dates. They must play out every hole.
- 2. Flights:** All competitors will be flighted based on handicaps and tees. First round pairing will be based on handicaps. Second round pairing will be based on first round results.
- 3. Tees:** Players competing for the title of "Club Champion" must play from the white tees. All other players will play from their declared tees.
- 4. Winner:** One Club Champion is determined by low gross among those players playing from the white tees. Ties will be settled with three (3) hole playoff on Holes 1, 2 and 3. Flight winners from all tees will be based on net score.
- 5. Purse:** Fees for both rounds to be paid on day of first round. Club Champion will be exempt from paying the following year's GHIN fee.

**Recognizing Breast Cancer Awareness Month:** Tuesday, October 5<sup>th</sup> (also our next General Meeting) will be 'Think Pink' day in recognition of breast cancer survivors. Everyone is encouraged to wear pink that day so we can honor them with our 'sea of pink.' We have at least 5 survivors in our Club. There will also be a special game involving a pink ball, which everyone will hear more about that day.
