This document has been created as a guide to be used in the planning process when setting the play day tournament schedule for the upcoming year. It may be modified from time to time as needed.

Tournament Scheduling Guidelines

General Meetings -

General Meetings (GM) are held on the 1st Tuesday of each month, therefore to accommodate our "out of town" members, the game on a GM day must be a format facilitating quick play (i.e. Scramble format, etc.)

HSTP Qualifying Rounds -

1. Must be a postable round
2. Recommended to be held on the last Tuesday of the month or 3 weeks prior to the actual HSTP tournament
 - Week 1 - Allow remainder of qualifying week for;
 - Play qualifying round
 - Scoring round and determine qualifiers, rankings, pairings, etc.
 - Initiate notification of qualifiers and alternates
 - Week 2 - Allow the 2nd week for;
 - a. Confirmation of Team and Alternates
 - b. Registering qualified player on NNGA HSTP website 7 days before Tournament
 - c. Replace any registered players who must drop out with alternates as needed
 - Week 3 - Adjustments to Team allowed until day before tournament

Presidents Cup and Club Championship -

1. Presidents Cup should be held in August
2. Presidents Cup will be stroke play eclectic
3. Club Championship should be held in September
4. Club Championship will be stroke play
5. Each will be played on two consecutive days or weeks

Closing Luncheon -

The Closing Luncheon (CL) is held on the last Tuesday of the season and like the GM days the game of the day must be a format facilitating fast play (i.e. Scramble format, etc.)

Tee Time -

The Tee Time during the season will be adjusted due to climate and daylight as follows;

Month	Time	Reason
April	9:30 am	Cold & frost
May – August	8:30 am	Heat
September – October	9:00 am	Darkness

Rounds -

1. Ladies day play will commence on the first Tuesday of April
2. There shall be no fewer than 27 nor more than 29 round of play ending no later than the 2nd Tuesday of October
3. Schedule should consist of a minimum of 20 postable rounds
