9-Hole League Guidelines

Introduction:

The Nine & Dine League is perfect for those who are just starting their golfing journey, who don't have the time or stamina to commit to 18-hole play, or who haven't previously played in a women's golf league. It will give new players an opportunity to start learning the many rules of golf and how they apply on the course, and to understand how league play operates.

League Format/Guidelines:

- The home course for the Carson Valley Women's Golf Club (CVWGC) is the Carson Valley Golf Course.
- Membership dues in the Club provide players with the opportunity to play in both the 9-hole and 18-hole leagues, provided they they meet minimum qualifying requirements. (See the last two bullet points for qualifying information.)
- To determine which tees you should play from, we encourage you to use the **Tee Selection Calculator** located on the front page of the club website: www.cvwgc.com.
- League play is every Wednesday morning starting the second week of April through the end of October, except the first week of every month. On the first week of every month the Nine & Dine League will join the 18-hole league on Tuesday for a theme play day, lunch and socializing, and the General Membership Meeting. There will not be any reserved tee times on the first Wednesday of the month.
- Starting times throughout the season will be:
 - April: 9:30 a.m.
 - May and June: 8:30 a.m.
 - July and August: 8:00 a.m.
 - September and October: 9:30 a.m.

Note – The tee time is not a shotgun start but regular successive tee times (e.g. 9:30 am first foursome, 9:37 am second foursome, etc.).
- Players will call the Pro Shop (775) 265-3181 by Saturday, 1:00 p.m., to reserve their spot in one of the reserved tee times. A spot cannot be guaranteed with the Nine & Dine League for any calls that are made after the 1:00 p.m. deadline.
- League Chairs may elect to set up a fun game for the players. Participation in the game is optional.
- Any player who makes a birdie is eligible to fill out a birdie, put it on the Birdie Board, and receive a birdie pin at the end of the season.
- After playing, players have the option to go out to lunch at a local restaurant.
- Players are required to post their own scores in GHIN every time they play to keep their handicap accurate and up to date or to establish a handicap if they do not have one yet.

9-Hole League Guidelines

- Playing only in the Nine & Dine League makes you ineligible for the Eclectic at the end of the season. However, if you qualify for 18-hole play, you may elect to play in both the President's Cup and Club Championship tournaments.
- Players with a handicap of 45+ are not eligible to play in the 18-hole league until their handicap moves below 45.
- Nine & Dine players with a handicap less than 45 can elect to play in both the Nine & Dine and 18-Hole Leagues.
