

General Membership Meeting Notes September 5, 2023

Judy Brooke called the meeting called to order at 2:10 p.m. after everyone finished their delicious chili-cheese dogs.

DISCUSSION ITEMS:

- 2024 Club Officer nominations concluded on 8/31/23. All four officers from the 2023 season were nominated to remain in their positions. Judy Brooke as President, Vickie Oland as Vice President, Lorna Johnston as Secretary and Debbie Steele as Treasurer.
- An email was sent out on September 1st for Club Officer voting. Please complete voting by no later than September 15th.
- Debbie Steele, our trusty Treasurer, gave me what we have in our accounts:

- Judy gave a big thank you to both D-D and Jan who made this monthly theme—Rhinestone Cowgirl—happen!
- October is "Think Pink" month. 100% of our 50/50 raffle funds will be donated to a breast cancer awareness organization still to be identified. - Judy reminded everyone that our start time until the end of the season is 9:00 a.m.
- Judy reviewed Net Double Bogey. First, you should not pick up your ball on a hole BEFORE reaching net double bogey. Here is an example for hole #10, a Par 5:
 - Net Double Bogey on a Par 5 is 7 + your pops. Let's say I have 2 pops on that hole, I would pick up my ball at 9 shots and then estimate the number of shots I most likely would have taken to finish. For me, I would add 3 if I had one chip shot and then two putts giving me a 12. Especially on Tuesdays, we are encouraging you to use this if you find you have groups waiting behind you or find that your foursome is falling behind the group in front of them.
- Our last official play day is Tuesday, October 17th. After play, we will have our year end luncheon where we acknowledge and honor Club members for their achievements. This year the banquet will be held in the Clubhouse and Chef Steve will be preparing something special for us. We will share more details later this month. As in the past, the Women's Golf Club will be subsidizing the luncheon so the price will be reasonable.
